First Generation

1. **Unknown JOHNSTON** was born (date unknown).

Elizabeth UNKNOWN was born in 1773 in Maryland. This according to the 1850 Census, which shows an Elizabeth Johnston, age 77 and born in Maryland, to be living with Brownlee Johnston in the Third Ward of the City of Pittsburgh. Elizabeth is presumed to be Brownlee's mother.

Unknown JOHNSTON and Elizabeth UNKNOWN had the following child:

 - i. **Brownlee JOHNSTON**, born about 1812, Ohio; married Eliza Ann RAE, March 24, 1840, Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co., Pennsylvania; died November 28, 1874, West Wheatfield Twp., Indiana County, Pennsylvania.

Second Generation

2. **Brownlee JOHNSTON** was born about 1812 in Ohio. He died on November 28, 1874 at the age of 62 in West Wheatfield Twp., Indiana County, Pennsylvania. According to the International Genealogical Index (no source cited), Brown Lee Johnson, born 1802 in Pennsylvania was married in 1827 to Eliza Ann Rae, born 1806 in Lawrenceville (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. This data is highly questionable, because all census data consistently indicate that Brownlee was born about 1812 and Eliza was born about 1820, making an 1827 marriage unlikely.

According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson, in 2009, Brownlee Johnson and Eliza Ray were married on March 24, 1840. This source is believed to be accurate.

According to the 1840 Census, which shows heads of households only, a "Brown L Johnson", age 20-30, lived in the South Ward (3rd Wd) of the City of Pittsburgh. One female, age 20-30, presumably Brownlee's wife, lived in the same household. (An Edward Johnson, age 20-30, is next on the 1840 Census list.) The population of Pittsburgh and Allegheny City in 1840 was 21,515.

On April 10, 1845, the City of Pittsburgh, including the South Ward, burned to the ground. The fire destroyed over 1500 structures in just five hours.

According to the 1850 Census, Brownlee Johnston, age 38 (born abt. 1812), a carpenter born in in Ohio, lived in the Third Ward of the City of Pittsburgh with his wife, Eliza W. (30) (born abt. 1820), and children: Elizabeth (10), Henry (8), John (6), and Winifred (1) and Elizabeth Johnson (77), presumably Brownlee's mother, who is shown to have been born in Maryland. According to Fahnestock's Pittsburgh Directory for 1850, Brownlee was a carpenter who lived/worked on Fleming Street in Allegheny. The 1852 Pittsburgh City Directory shows the same information. Fleming Street was also known as Clay Alley.

According to the 1860 Census, "Brown L. Johnston", age 48 (born abt. 1812) and born in Ohio, lived in the 3rd Wd. of the City of Pittsburgh with Eliza A. (39) (born abt. 1821), presumably his wife, and Henry H. (18), John (15), Robert M. (6) and Frank (4) (presumably his children). Brownlee and Robert are said to be carpenters. A Gilman W.(23) and Elizabeth (19) Davis, presumably Brownlee's son-in-law and daughter, were living with Brownlee and his family in 1860. Gilman was born in Ohio.

According to the 1870 Census, Brownlee, age 58 (born abt. 1812), lived with Eliza, age 50 (born abt. 1820), and Harry, age 28, and Frank, age 14. They lived in the 2nd Ward of Allegheny City. Brownlee and Harry were house carpenters, Frank worked in a tin shop and Eliza kept house. According to the Pittsburgh City Directory in 1870, Brownlee Johnson was a carpenter living at 106 Fremont Avenue in Allegheny City in 1870. The 1871 and 1872 Pittsburgh City Directories shows the same thing, and Henry Johnson, also a carpenter was also living at 106 Fremont Ave. in Allegheny City. In 1870, the population of Pittsburgh and Allegheny City was 139,500. Given the remarkable growth of the City in the 30 years since 1840, Brownlee must have enjoyed steady work as a carpenter.

The 1873 Pittsburgh City Directory shows that Louise Johnston, Henry's wife was a widow living at 20 Clay Alley. Likewise the 1875 Pittsburgh City Directory. Clay Alley was located in Allegheny City. The 1876 Pittsburgh City Directory also shows Eliza Johnston, a widow, also living at 20 Clay Alley in Allegheny City. Thus, it appears that Brownlee died between November 20, 1872 and 1876.

By deed dated November 20, 1872, and recorded in Indiana County, Pennsylvania, on December 11, 1872 (Deed No. 3043, Deed Book A37, Page 353), Brownlee Johnson, of the second ward in the City of Pittsburgh acquired two parcels of property containing 90 and 180 acres of property in West Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania from Edward Pipstill (sp.?) for \$7,500.00. According to the description of the property in the deed (and confirmed by a map from Beers Atlas dated 1871), the property bordered property owned by J. Johnson (or Johnston).

According to a record in the Recorder's Office of Indiana County (No. 3034), on December 14, 1874, Letters of Administration were granted to Eliza A. Johnson for the estate of her late husband Brown Lee Johnson, who died on November 28, 1874 at 4:00 p.m. He had died intestate.

The December 24, 1874 edition of the Indiana Progress, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, has a legal notice to the effect that Eliza A. Johnston had been granted letters of administration for the estate of Brownlee Johnston, who had died in Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.

According to an inventory filed with the Indiana County Orphan's Court by Eliza A. Johnson (Orphan's Court No. 10-260), Brownlee died with the following issue: (i) Elizabeth, married to G. W. Davis, but lately deceased, leaving one child, Estella May Davis, a minor having for her guardian Israel Doty, Esq., (ii) Henry Harrison Johnson, (iii) John Johnson, lately deceased, leaving surviving a widow named Hannah C. Johnson and four children: Lillie Mary, Henry Ray, Brownlee and Robert, all of whom are minors, having for their guardian Franklin Johnston, and (iv) Franklin Johnston. This record confirms that John Johnson was married to Hannah C. and the names of their children, including Brownlee.

The October 3, 1878 edition of the Indiana Progress contains a legal notice of an order of the Orphan's Court, ordering the sale of the property of Brownlee Johnston, deceased, containing 175 acres, 140 of which are cleared and including a frame house.

Thus, Brownlee and his wife had moved to West Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania in the early 1870's, and Brownlee died in 1874.

According to the 1880 Census, E. A Johnston, age 60 (born abt. 1820) and born in Pennsylvania, was keeping house. She lived with Hannah Johnston (age 35), her daughter-in-law (it is not clear who Hannah's husband was) and her grandchildren: Lilly (13), Harry R. (13), Brownlee (10) and Robert (8). Also living in the house were her son Frank (24) and Estella Davis (17), who is listed as her grand-daughter. Four borders also lived in the house.

Brownlee JOHNSTON and Eliza Ann RAE were married on March 24, 1840 in Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co., Pennsylvania. **Eliza Ann RAE** was born about 1820 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. She died before 1880 at the age of 60. According to the International Genealogical Index (no source cited), Elisa Ann Rae, born 1806 in Lawrenceville (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania, was married in 1827 to Brown Lee Johnson, born 1802 in Pennsylvania.

According to the 1880 Census, E. A Johnston, age 60 and born in Pennsylvania, was keeping house. She lived with Hannah Johnston (age 35), her daughter-in-law (it is not clear who Hannah's husband was) and her grandchildren: Lilly (13), Harry R. (13), Brownlee (10) and Robert (8). Also living in the house were her son Frank (24) and Estella Davis (17), who is listed as her grand-daughter. Four borders also lived in the house.

Brownlee JOHNSTON and Eliza Ann RAE had the following children:

- +3 i. **Elizabeth JOHNSON**, born December 22, 1840, Pennsylvania; married Gilman Warren DAVIS, July 4, 1860; died before 1880.
- +4 ii. **Henry Harrison "Harry" JOHNSON**, born October 19, 1842, Pennsylvania; married Phaene NEWTON, June 11, 1877; died April 2, 1906.
- +5 iii. **John JOHNSON**, born January 29, 1845; married Hannah C. DAVIS; died September 22, 1873.
- 6 iv. **Winifred JOHNSTON** was born in 1849. She died in 1851 at the age of 2. All information regarding Winifred was derived from a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009. This source is believed to be accurate. This source is consistent with the 1850 census, which shows a Winifred, age 1, living with Brownlee and Eliza.
- 7 v. **Annebell JOHNSTON** was born in 1851. She died in 1852 at the age of 1. All information regarding Annebell was derived from a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009. This source is believed to be accurate.
- 8 vi. **Robert Mowry JOHNSON** was born in 1853 in Pennsylvania. He died in 1868 at the age of 15. He was buried on July 23, 1868 in Union Dale Cemetery, Northside (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. Robert was buried in 1868 in a plot in Union Dale Cemetery in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, owned by Brownlee Johnson. It appears that Franklin Johnson, who was buried in 1925, was buried in the same grave.

According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009, Robert was born in 1853 with the middle name "Mowry" and he died in 1868. This source is believed to be accurate.
- +9 vii. **Franklin "Frank" JOHNSON**, born July 18, 1860; married Mary Elisabeth ASHCOM, 1896; died July 8, 1925.

Third Generation

3. **Elizabeth JOHNSON** was born on December 22, 1840 in Pennsylvania. She died before 1880 at the age of 40. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson, in 2009, Elizabeth was born on December 22, 1840. She is shown to have married Gilman Warren Davis on July 4, 1860 and to have had two daughters: Estella May Davis, born May 12, 1863, and Clara Annabell, born April 25, 1861

(although Clara's name is in parentheses for some reason). This source is believed to be accurate.

Elizabeth JOHNSON and Gilman Warren DAVIS were married on July 4, 1860. **Gilman Warren DAVIS** was born in 1832 in Ohio. He died on March 15, 1901 at the age of 69 in Dayton, Ohio. He was buried in National Military Cemetery, Dayton, Montgomery Co., Ohio. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson, in 2009, Gilman's middle name was Warren and he was married to Elizabeth on July 4, 1860. This source is believed to be accurate.

According to the 1860 census, Gilman W. Davis, born about 1837, lived with his wife Elizabeth, born about 1839, in the household of Brownlee Johnston in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania. He was born in Ohio and worked as a blacksmith.

According to the *U.S. Civil War Soldier Records and Profiles* compiled by Historical Data Systems, and available on Ancestry.com, Gilman W. Davis, enlisted in Independent Battery H of the Pennsylvania Light Artillery of the Union Army on February 29, 1864. He was mustered out of service on June 18, 1865 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

According to the 1870 census, George Davis, born about 1832, lived with his wife Elizabeth, born about 1841, with a daughter Stella, born about 1863. He was born in Ohio and worked as a blacksmith.

According to the 1880 census, an Estella M. Davis, born about 1863, was living with Eliza Johnston, born about 1820 (widow of Brownlee Johnston). Estella is listed as Eliza's granddaughter. Neither Gilman nor Elizabeth Davis are members of the household; presumably, Elizabeth had died by 1880.

According to the records of the *U.S. National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, 1866-1938*, available on Ancestry.com, Gilman W. Davis was admitted into the National Military Home near Dayton, Ohio on March 14, 1893, having heart disease and other problems. He was 58 years old, lived in Allegheny City, Pennsylvania and he worked as a blacksmith. He was a widower. His nearest relative was his daughter, Essella (sic.) M. Edgar, 165 McClure Street, Allegheny, Pa.

According to the 1900 census, Gilman W. Davis, born October 1833, lived at the National Military Home (Incl. Central Branch) in Montgomery, Ohio. He is shown to have been born in Ohio and he was a widower.

According to the National Cemetery Administration's *U.S. Veterans Gravesites, ca.1775-2006*, Gilman W. Davis died on 15 Mar 1901 and was buried on the same date at the Dayton National Cemetery, VA Medical Center 4100 West Third Street Dayton, OH 45428, Section M Row 12 Site 22. He is shown to have entered service on February 29, 1864 and served as a privated in the artillery in the Civil War. According to the records of the *U.S. National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, 1866-1938*, available on Ancestry.com, his personal effects were sent to his daughter, Estella M Edgar, 600 Woods Run Ave., Allegheny City, Pa.

Gilman Warren DAVIS and Elizabeth JOHNSON had the following children:

- 10 i. **Clara Annabell DAVIS** was born on April 25, 1861.
- +11 ii. **Estella May DAVIS**, born May 12, 1863, Pennsylvania; married Robert F. EDGAR, about 1887.

4. **Henry Harrison "Harry" JOHNSON** was born on October 19, 1842 in Pennsylvania. He died on April 2, 1906 at the age of 63. He was buried in Leavenworth National Cemetery, Leavenworth, Kansas. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009, Henry was born on October 19, 1842. He is shown to have married Ida Newton (Johnson) on June 11, 1877. No children are shown. This source is believed to be accurate.

According to the 1870 census, Henry was living with his parents in Allegheny City, Pennsylvania. His occupation is shown to be a house carpenter.

According to the 1872 Pittsburgh City Directory, Henry H. Johnston, a carpenter, was living at 106 Fremont Ave., Allegheny City.

According to the 1880 census, Henry, a carpenter, was living with his wife, Phaene (?), and his two children: Ida, age 3, and Ella, age 11/12. It appears that the handwritten family tree written above may have confused his child "Ida" for his wife.

According to the records of the U.S. National Homes for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers, 1866-1938, available on Ancestry.com, Henry enlisted in the army on February 29, 1864 and was discharged on June 19, 1865. He was admitted to the home in Dayton Ohio on April 22, 1897. He is shown to be a widower. He was discharged from the Dayton Home on August 11, 1900, when he was transferred to Western Pennsylvania. The contact shown in the record is his daughter, Mrs. R. H. Griffith in Omaha, Nebraska.

According to the 1900 census, Henry H. Johnson, born October 1842, was an "inmate" in Central Branch, National Home for Disabled Volunteers, Dayton, Montgomery Co., Ohio.

According to the Leavenworth, Kansas Register, he died on April 2, 1906. His son-in-law, R. H. Griffith, of Wheeler, Washington, was notified. It is not clear from the record where he died (Kansas or Western Pennsylvania) or where he was buried.

Henry Harrison "Harry" JOHNSON and Phaene NEWTON were married on June 11, 1877. **Phaene NEWTON** was born about 1856 in Pennsylvania. She died before April, 1897 at the age of 41. Both the given name and surname of Henry's wife needs to be confirmed. The surname "Newton" comes from a Johnson family Bible; however, it says her given name was Ida and according to the 1880 census, that was the name of his daughter. According to the 1880 census, Henry's wife's given name was "Phaene," which is not a recognizable name.

Henry Harrison JOHNSON and Phaene NEWTON had the following children:

- 12 i. **Ida JOHNSON** was born in 1877 in Pennsylvania.
- 13 ii. **Ella JOHNSON** was born in 1879 in Pennsylvania.

5. **John JOHNSON** was born on January 29, 1845. He died on September 22, 1873 at the age of 28. He was buried in Union Dale Cemetery, Northside (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009, John was born on January 29, 1845. He is shown to have married Hannah C. Davis on September 11, 1866. (Note: It was originally assumed that Hannah was the wife of John's brother, Henry (Harry) Johnson. This assumption has been discarded based on this "family tree". The database now shows Hannah to be the wife of John. However, it is believed that

Hannah's maiden name was Byers, not Davis.) The family tree shows John and Hannah to have had four children: Brownlee, Robert, and twins Harry and Lillian, born August 27, 1867. This source is believed to be accurate.

John and his wife Hannah and their family cannot be located in the 1870 census.

John's grave marker indicates that he was a Seargant in Co. 1 of the 109th Pennsylvania Volunteers in the Civil War. According to the History of Pennsylvania Volunteers (Samuel P. Bates, 1870 and 1993), John was mustered into the army on January 25, 1862. He was wounded at Pine Knob, Georgia on June 15, 1864 while with Sherman's Army, and he was discharged on January 25, 1865 after serving his three year term.

According to his obituary, John was 26 when he died in 1873.

John is buried in a plot with a William Sproull, who was buried on May 7, 1853. Mr. Sproull may not be any relation to John Johnson. The plot was owned by Mrs. Sarah Sproull before it was transferred by letter to John S/G(?) Johnson. The cemetery records indicate that Frank Johnson had a letter showing this transfer. Presumably, Frank would have had to produced that letter when he buried John in 1873, when Frank was 17 years old. The fact that Frank held this letter at such a young age suggests that John and Frank's father, Brownlee, may have been dead by 1873. (Brother Robert had died in 1868.)

John's death notice indicates that he was 26 when he died, meaning he was born in 1847. However, according to the 1860 Census, John was 15 in 1860, meaning that he was born in 1845.

According to John's death certificate, available on FamilySearch.org (2012), John died of a "laceration of the brain from fracture of skull". He lived in the hospital for three weeks before he died. He was a carpenter.

John JOHNSON and Hannah C. DAVIS were married. **Hannah C. DAVIS** was born in May, 1845. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, in 2009, Hannah C. Davis married John Johnson on September 11, 1866. (Note: It was originally assumed that Hannah was the wife of John's brother, Henry (Harry) Johnson. This assumption has been discarded based on this "family tree". The database now shows Hannah to be the wife of John.) The family tree shows John and Hannah to have had four children: Brownlee, Robert, and twins Harry and Lillian, born August 27, 1867. This source is belived to be accurate.

According to the 1880 census, Eliza Johnston lived with with a daughter-in-law, Hannah Johnston (age 35). John had died in 1873, so Hannah and their children were living with their mother and grandmother in 1880. The children were: Lilly (13), Harry R. (13), Brownlee (10) and Robert (8).

According to the 1900 census, Hannah (spelled Hanna in the census) was living with her daughter Lillian (spelled Lellia in the census) and her family (her husband William and children William, Russell (spelled Russel in the census) and Benjamin in Steubenville, Jefferson Co., Ohio.

John JOHNSON and Hannah C. DAVIS had the following children:

- +14 i. **Lillian Mae JOHNSON**, born August 27, 1867; married William F. BUTLER.
- +15 ii. **Harry Rae JOHNSON Sr.**, born August 27, 1867; married Ella Jane BYERS, 1891; died March 26, 1920.
- +16 iii. **Brownlee "Brown" JOHNSON**, born September, 1869, Pennsylvania; married Maud Elizabeth BUTLER, about 1894; died before 1940.
- +17 iv. **Robert G. JOHNSON**, born August 14, 1871, Pennsylvania; married Elsie Agnes GEORGE;

died August 1, 1961, Indiana, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.

9. **Franklin "Frank" JOHNSON** was born on July 18, 1860. He died on July 8, 1925 at the age of 64. He was buried on July 11, 1925 in Union Dale Cemetery, Northside (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. According to Mary Sloan Funk, Frank was born in Undercliff (Etna), PA. His death certificate says he was born on July 18, 1860 in Allegheny City, Pennsylvania.

According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained in 2009 from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson Farmin, Franklin Johnson was born on January 18, 1856. He married Mary E. Ashcom in 1896 and they had four children: John Franklin, born August 1, 1897; Ray Brownlee, born December 18, 1898; Martha Helen, born October 6, 1901; and Emma Elizabeth, born January 31, 1909. This source is believed to be accurate.

According to Mary Sloan Funk, Frank lived in Undercliff, a place name in Shaler Township, Pennsylvania in his early years. In fact, the 1910 Census indicates that Frank and his family were living on Old Butler Pike, in Shaler, Pennsylvania, where Undercliff is located, in 1910. Thus, while Frank did not live in Undercliff in his early years, it appears that his daughter Emma, from whom Mary Sloan Funk likely heard that information, did. According to his death certificate, he was a messenger for Bellevue Savings & Trust Co. At his death, he was living at 533 Marie Ave., Avalon, PA. He died of bronchial pneumonia. He was buried from Cray Bros. Funeral Home in Bellevue, Pennsylvania.

The following death notice appeared in July 9, 1925 edition of The Pittsburgh Gazette Times:

Johnson--On Wednesday, July 8, 1925, at 12:30 p.m., FRANKLIN JOHNSON, beloved husband of Mary Ashcom Johnson.

Funeral service at his late residence, 533 Marie avenue, Avalon, Pa., Friday evening, July 10, 9 o'clock. Friends of the family are respectfully invited to attend.

Interment Saturday morning.

Franklin "Frank" JOHNSON and Mary Elisabeth ASHCOM were married in 1896. **Mary Elisabeth ASHCOM**, daughter of John ASHCOM and Martha Jane GOHN, was born on September 7, 1875 in New Florence, Pennsylvania. She died on February 19, 1961 at the age of 85 in Ben Avon, Pennsylvania. She was buried on February 23, 1961 in Union Dale Cemetery, Northside (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. According to her death certificate, Mary was born in New Florence, Pennsylvania, a small town 10 miles west of Johnstown, Pennsylvania. According to Dr. Frank Johnson, because many members of the family worked for the railroad (her brother Ray was an engineer on the Pennsylvania Railroad), the Ashcom family was known as a "railroad family". Interestingly, she signed her mother's death certificate as Mrs. F Johnston. At that time (May 21, 1920), she was living at 316 Marie Ave. in Avalon, Pennsylvania. Mary later lived on Breeding Ave. in Ben Avon, Pennsylvania. Later in her life, she lived with her daughter, Emma Johnson Farmin, and did much of the cooking for Emma's catering business. According to Mary's death notice, she lived at 308 Breeding Ave., Ben Avon, Pennsylvania when she died. She died of arterioscleratic heart disease. According to her obituary, at her death, she had eight grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. Her funeral was from McDonald Funeral Home, 529 California Ave., Avalon, Pennsylvania.

Franklin JOHNSON and Mary Elisabeth ASHCOM had the following children:

- +18 i. **John Franklin JOHNSON**, born August 1, 1897; married Mary W. WOODBURN, December

- 8, 1921; died April 22, 1927, Bellevue, Allegheny Co., Pennsylvania.
- +19 ii. **Ray Brownlee JOHNSON**, born December 18, 1898, Pennsylvania; died October, 1952.
- +20 iii. **Martha Helen JOHNSON**, born October 6, 1901, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; married Robert William SLOAN, April 8, 1926, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; died August 9, 1987, St. Petersburg, Florida.
- +21 iv. **Emma Elizabeth JOHNSON**, born January 31, 1909; married William Arlow FARMIN, July 10, 1930; died February 20, 1998, Scottsdale, Arizona.

Fourth Generation

11. **Estella May DAVIS** was born on May 12, 1863 in Pennsylvania. According to a handwritten "family tree" obtained from Corrine Farmin, daughter of Emma Johnson, in 2009, Estella's middle name was May and she was born on May 12, 1863. This source is believed to be accurate.

Estella May DAVIS and Robert F. EDGAR were married about 1887. **Robert F. EDGAR** was born in April, 1862 in Ireland. He died in Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co., Pennsylvania.

Robert F. EDGAR and Estella May DAVIS had the following children:

According to the 1930 census, William was living with his parents on Campus Street, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in 1930. He is shown to be a civil engineer with his own office.

According to the 1940 census, William was living with his mother on Campus Street, in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania in 1920. He is shown to be single.

According to his WW II draft registration card, dated 1942, William was living with his mother at 3546 Campus Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in 1942. He was employed by Foundry Equipment Company, located in the Oliver Building in Pittsburgh.

14. **Lillian Mae JOHNSON** was born on August 27, 1867. According to Lilly's brother's (Harry's) obituary, Harry was survived by a sister identified as Mrs. J. M. Bulter, of Avalon. That this Mrs. Butler is in fact Lilly,

needs to be confirmed.

According to the 1910 Census, a Lillie M. Butler, age 72 (this is incorrect) and head of the household, was living in 13th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh in 1910 with her children Russell J. (age 13), Benjamin A. (age 11) and Bessie E. (age 8) and her mother Hannah C. Johnson, age 67. This confirms that this is the correct Lillian. Lillie is shown to be married, but her husband is not living in the house.

The 1920 census shows a Lillian M. Butler, a widow, living in the 19th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh. She is the head of the household, with two children--Benjamin B. (age 21) and Catherine (age 18) (who could have been the "Bessie" shown in the 1910 Census, although this difference in names cannot be explained).

According to the 1930 census, Lillian was living with her daughter Catherine and her husband, Andrew J. Heitzman on Sheridan Ave. in Pittsburgh.

Lillian Mae JOHNSON and William F. BUTLER were married. **William F. BUTLER** was born in December, 1866 in Ohio. He died before 1920 at the age of 54. According to Lillian Johnson's brother's death notice, Lillian was referred to as Mrs. J.M. Butler and living in Avalon in 1920.

According to the 1900 census, his name is William and he was living with his family (William, age 8; Russell, age 3; and Benjamin, age 1) and mother-in-law, Hanna Johnson, in Steubenville, Jefferson Co., Ohio. He was a salesman. Lillian's husband does not appear in the 1910 or 1920 censuses.

Harry was originally buried in a plot with John S/G(?) Johnson. He was moved to a plot owned by his wife, Ella, on December 1, 1949. We are assuming that Harry was Harry Johnson's son, although he could have been John's or Robert's son. This needs to be confirmed.

The following Death Notice and Death Record in the March 27, 1920 edition of the Pittsburg Press:

Pittsburg; two brothers, B.L. Johnson, New Kensington, and Robert G. Johnson, Blairsville, and a sister, Mrs. J.M. Butler, Avalon.

Harry Rae JOHNSON Sr. and Ella Jane BYERS were married in 1891. **Ella Jane BYERS** was born on January 26, 1873. She died on August 29, 1958 at the age of 85. She was buried on September 2, 1958 in Union Dale Cemetery, Northside (Pittsburgh), Pennsylvania. The following obituary appeared in the August 30, 1958 edition of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette:

Johnson--On Friday, Aug. 29, 1958, at the house of her granddaughter, Verna Skidmore Kuhlber, 120 Fisk Ave., Avalon, Ella Byers, wife of the late Harry R. Johnson; mother of Harry R. According to the 1900 Census, a "Brown Johnson", born 1869 was married to Maud and was living with his children, Clifford, Margaret and Martin S., in the 18th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh. Given that we know from the 1880 Census that a Brownlee Johnson was born in 1880, probably to John and Hannah Johnson, it will be assumed here, given the unusual name, that Brown was John and Hannah's son, Brownlee. This needs to be confirmed.

According to a death certificate found at:

http://www.wvculture.org/vrr/va_view2.aspx?FilmNumber=857525&ImageNumber=90, Brown and Maud had a stillborn child on February 3, 1903 in Wheeling, West Virginia. They named the child Frank. He was buried at Peninsula cemetery.

The 1910 census shows "Brown L." (further evidence that this is the Brownlee from the 1880 census), age 40 (i.e., born about 1870), living with Maud and their children in New Kensington, Westmoreland Co., Pennsylvania.

The names of the children in this census are very confusing:

Brownlee "Brown" JOHNSON and Maud Elizabeth BUTLER were married about 1894. **Maud Elizabeth BUTLER** was born in July, 1873 in Ohio, Fayette Co., Pennsylvania. According to an entry in ancestry.com's OneWorldTree, Maud's last name was Butler. According to Polk's City Directory for New Kensington, in 1940, Maud was a widow and lived at 525-1/2 Earl Ave. with her son Kenneth.

According to the 1920 Census, Robert G. Johnson, age 49 (b. abt. 1871), lived with his wife Elsie, age 42, their two daughters, Roberta, age 17, Margaret, age 16, his mother-in-law, Annie B. George, age 69, and his brother-in-law, age 46. Robert was a plumber.

According to the 1930 Census, Robert G. Johnson, age 59 (b. abt. 1871), lived with his wife Elsie, age 52, their two daughters, Roberta, age 27, Margaret, age 26, and his brother-in-law, James, age 58. Robert was a plumber.

According to the 1940 census, Robert and Elsie lived in Blairsville, Indiana Co., Pennsylvania, next door to their daughter Margaret and her husband, William Bronson.

According to an obituary published in the Indiana Evening Gazette of Indiana Co., Pennsylvania, on August 2, 1961:

"Robert G. Johnson of 241 E. Market Stret, Blairsville, died at 11 p.m. August 1, 1961, in the Indiana Hospital.

He was born in Pittsburgh, August 14, 1871, son of John and Hannah Byers Johnson. He had been a plumber in Blairsville for more than 60 years and retired in 1951. He was a member of the Hebron Lutheran Church, Blairsville, and the L.O.O.M.

Surviving is one daughter, Mrs. William (Margaret) Bronson of Falls Church, Va. One daughter, Mrs Roberta Swope preceded her father in death, and his wife Elsie George Johnson died in January 1961.

Friends will be received after 7 p.m. today at the J. Freeman Ferfuson and Son Funeral Home, Blairsville where services will be held Friday, August 4, at 3 p.m. The Rev. James M. Robbins wil officiate and interment wil follow in Oakland Cemetery, Indiana."

Robert G. JOHNSON and Elsie Agnes GEORGE were married. **Elsie Agnes GEORGE** was born in December, 1877 in Pennsylvania. She died in January, 1961 at the age of 83 in Pennsylvania.

According to John's death certificate, John died at 10:00 a.m. on April 22, 1927 at the Suburban General Hospital in Bellevue, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. The cause of death is shown to be "(Suicide) due to taking Bichromide of mercury tablets". His birthday is listed as August 1, 1897. He was a clerk at the Standard Seamless Tube Co. at the time of his death. He is shown to be married to Mary Woodburn Johnson; his father was Franklin Johnson and his mother was Mary Ashcom. The death certificate appears to have been signed by R.B. Johnson, his brother, whose address is shown to be 221 S. Starr Avenue, Avalon, Pa. He is shown to have been buried in Union Dale Cemetery by Cray Bros., Bellevue, Pa.

John's obituary, published in the Pittsburgh Press on Saturday, April 23, 1927 reads as follows:

JOHNSON--On Friday, April 22, 1927, at 10:00 a.m., at the Suburban General hospital, Bellevue, Pa., John F. Johnson, beloved husband of Mary Woodburn Johnson, aged 29 years. Funeral from the residence of his father-in-law, Robert R. Woodburn, 822 Florence ave., Avalon, Pa. Services Sunday afternoon, April 24 at 3 o'clock. Members of Avonworth Post American Legion and friends of family are respectfully invited to attend. Interment private Monday morning.

The Standard Seamless Tube Company (founded in 1913) was located at the north end of Ambridge, Pennsylvania. The offices were located at 23rd Street off Duss Avenue, Ambridge, Pennsylvania. Standard Seamless Tube later became Spang-Chalfant (1928), and Armco Steel Corporation (1958).

John Franklin JOHNSON and Mary W. WOODBURN were married on December 8, 1921. **Mary W. WOODBURN**, daughter of Robert Riley WOODBURN and Martha W. YOUNG, was born on May 19, 1894. She died on December 13, 1949 at the age of 55. She was buried in Allegheny Co. Memorial Park, Allison Park, Pennsylvania. According to the 1930 Census, Mary lived with her father at 822 Florence Ave., Avalon, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania with her two sons, Jack and Robert. She worked as a stenographer at a steel company.

Mary lived most of her life at 822 Florence Ave., Avalon, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.

John was a semi-talented wood-worker, turning out and giving away thousands of wood crafts over the years, before retiring from this hobby in 2009.

John was a faithful Christian who, especially after his retirement, devoted much time to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Whitehall, Pennsylvania (where he was a member (charter) for over 40 years), serving in numerous capacities, from Sunday School lecturer to fill-in janitor.

Born into a musical family on February 21, 1963, everyone knew that John Nallie would be a musician. He had no other choice. Music was to be his professional calling! His father Luther, a member of the Sons of the Pioneers since 1969, along with Luther's brother Tommy, saw to it that young John took up an instrument at an early age. John recalled, "My Uncle Tommy came to live with us. He had a band that rehearsed at our home. He would leave his drums set up in the living room, and I would bang on them every chance I got. Sensing that I had a

certain innate ability Tommy began teaching me how to play when I was five. Tommy and my Uncle Jack, who also performed with the Pioneers, were so caring, and so attached to music, all kinds, that I learned early on its importance. Of course, no one had a greater influence on my musical development than my father."

"I remember while we were living in the Black Forest in Colorado Springs, Colorado, when we would have an occasional family musical get-together, we would be joined by Dale Warren and his lovely wife Margie who played a mean fiddle. Back in the fifties and sixties Margie was known as "Fiddlin' Kate," and she was well respected for her talent. I'll never forget the pleasure we all experienced when former Pioneer Pat Brady would find time to join in. Pat was a funny man. At that time, I may not have realized the exact meaning of western music, but I sure knew Pioneer music when I heard it."

Entering the fifth grade upon the family's move back to Beaumont, Texas, John joined the school orchestra. The orchestra needed a violin player and although it was not his first choice, which was the instrument young Nallie took up. John comments, "After I had played in the orchestra for about two years I decided to try out for the school band playing drums. That was a lot of fun. When I was around twelve, and as I entered the seventh grade, I found a new interest--the guitar."

"When I turned eighteen," John went on, "I took an interest in the keyboards. My mom and dad bought me a little Casio keyboard for Christmas one year, and that's when I first took an interest in the synthesizer. It didn't take long for me to outgrow the Casio. At a music store in Beaumont I found that the Roland Company had come out with the JX3P keyboard and I just had to have it. I saved \$700.00 toward the purchase of the instrument, and my mom was kind enough to loan me an additional \$300.00 so I could complete the deal. Most of my time after that was spent playing the keyboard and guitar in local appearances."

In 1989 John became part of a group, *Mason Dixon*, that John refers to as the "most powerful bunch of singers I have ever heard." In particular he was impressed with the voice of its leader, Frank Gilligan. Shortly after *Mason Dixon* broke up, a friend Jim Caraway, who owned a piano bar in San Angelo, Texas called asking if John would consider filling in for him for a few weeks. John stated, "I ended up working for Jim for three winters, and while I was working in San Angelo, I was introduced to a very charming young girl, Daphne Stewart. We hit it off right away, and we were married in 1992. We now have three *wonderful* children, John, Karen, and Jeremy."

Wishing to be as close as possible to the magnetism of the music of the Sons of the Pioneers, John spent a couple of summers working behind the scenes in Branson. He accepted the responsibilities of setting up the stage for the group, doing sound-checks, and even going out to the lobby during intermission assisting in product sales. Not too long after he had returned to Beaumont, John was elated when he received a phone call from Dale Warren offering him a position with the group. "I couldn't say yes fast enough," he recalled. The official date of his joining was April, 1993.

John summed up his feelings in being a part of the legend of the Sons of the Pioneers, "It is an honor to have been accepted into the Pioneers. As you might expect, it was not that easy to fit into the trio. It took a lot of hard work, but in time I feel Gary, Dale, and I put together a trio sound that pleased us, and apparently our fans as well. Working with Gary and Dale in the trio gave me a sense of accomplishment that is almost impossible to put into words. Of course, every one of us fellows feels the obligation to uphold the reputation left us by Pioneers past."
